With my signature above, I, understanding the rules and format of the tournament, hereby grant permission for my child to participate in the Ray Scapinello 2010 Road Hockey Tournament and release and hold harmless the sponsors, promoters, and all other persons or entities associated with the event from any and all injury or damage for any claims or causes of action whatsoever for any loss or injury suffered by any child and/or myself. I also hereby grant permission for the Tournament Organizers to use the personal information provided for the sole purpose of administration of the Tournament.

PLAYING RULES

- Teams must have four players: Three players out and one goalie.
- Substitution is not allowed.
- All participants must wear a CSA approved helmet with full face protection, and hockey gloves at all times during play. Ice hockey equipment is permitted. Goalie pads of any sort are not permitted (goalies may wear normal hockey shin pads).**
- Each game is 25 minutes long (straight time), with two 12-minute halves. A face-off at centre starts both halves. A 1-minute break will be provided between periods.
- Possession: The last player to touch the ball before going out of bounds must forfeit the ball to the opposing team at the point of exit. Ample tennis balls will be made available at each playing site.
- A 3-minute penalty will be assessed to a player for any of the following infractions:
 - Slashing
 - Tripping
 - Body Contact
 - Slap-shots beyond centre
 - Abusive language
- When a goal is scored by the opposing team, the penalized team will return to full strength.
- No off sides or face-offs. Whistles are only to be blown for infractions and to end both periods.
- When a goal is scored, the team scored upon is given centre.
- Goalies are not allowed to cross centre.
- Tied games will result in a shoot-out, whereby each player is given a shot on net (a total of 3 shots per team) in order to break the tied game. If a tie still exists, then one shot is given to a player in turn on each team until the tie is broken.
- Games will not be rescheduled. If a team does not arrive within 5 minutes of game time, they shall default their game.
- The site coordinator's word is final!
- We reserve the right to eject anyone, player or spectator, for questionable conduct.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE RAY SCAPINELLO ROAD HOCKEY TOURNAMENT

1. Separate and complete the attached Registration Form. Give your team a name.
2. Please register as a team of FOUR players, all having birth dates within the same divisional guidelines. Those teams with members of different ages must play in the older division.
3. Ensure a parent or guardian signs for each player.
4. To register by mail enclose in an envelope

5. Each team is required to bring a GAME KEEPER (GK) as a member of their team for each game they play. This GK must be an adult. He or she will be paired up with the other teams GK to KEEP the game running cleanly, KEEP time and KEEP score. They will be responsible for being familiar with the rules that are outlined in this brochure. A Scapinello Co-coordinator will be provided at each site to outline the rules before each game and to record the final score.

Each team MUST have one GAME KEEPER for each game they play. Please indicate by checking the box on the registration form that your team understands this requirement.

6. Only fully completed registrations will be accepted. Registrations will be accepted until April 17th, 2010 or until full. An early-bird draw will be made from entries received on or before April 3rd, 2010 (Team Prize TBD).
7. A RAY SCAPINELLO ROAD HOCKEY TOURNAMENT volunteer will contact the Team Captain in late April regarding all tournament schedule details. All registered teams will receive an email or a written confirmation of their acceptance.
